

***What do you do when you are stressed out, feeling out of control, or parenting children and have no help?***

If you're feeling overwhelmed or like your family is in an unsafe situation, there is help for you – the Crisis Nursery serving Wright County offers free, confidential, and non-judgmental support and resources to parents and legal guardians of Wright County.

Parents can call a 24-hour helpline to talk to a trained, caring member of our team. Experienced staff are always available to help you find the resources your family needs.

If you need a safe place for your children, we have short-term, temporary, safe care available during the day or overnight.

### We offer:

- 24-hour crisis helpline: **763-271-1681**
- Support, resources, and referrals
- Short-term, temporary, safe care for your children (0-17 years) day or overnight while you tend to your family's needs
- Parent support groups
- Mental health services

### A parenting crisis could be:

- Feeling out of control, either physically or emotionally
- Loss of job
- Medical emergencies
- Housing issues
- Mental health issues, such as depression and chemical dependency
- Sudden illness or death in the family
- Family conflicts
- Simply not knowing how to parent a child
- Legal issues
- Financial stress
- Family dissolution or violence
- Loss of daycare which could lead to loss of employment

## How can you help?

- Be a foster home provider and care for children in your home on a short-term basis.
- Help facilitate parent support groups.
