

## Wastewater Odor Mitigation Project

### East Facility:

June 9, 2015 Entry: On June 8, 2015, the City Council approved the removal of solids from the east wastewater treatment facility (WWTF) by hauling it to a neighboring WWTF outside the City. This is anticipated to take approximately two weeks. The removal of solids will address the recent odor issues. Hauling will begin as soon as the outside facilities are prepared to receive the solids.

### West Facility:

June 9, 2015 Entry: On May 26, 2015, the City Council approved an engineering study to address the capacity and odor issues at the west WWTF. The capacity issue is the result of an under sizing of the digester when the facility was originally constructed. The under sizing was not discovered until the facility reached a capacity that could not be handled by the existing digester. Until the improvement project to construct a second digester is completed in 2016, interim measures are being taken to mitigate the odors. One of those interim measures is hauling solids to a WWTF outside the City while alternative mitigation measures are evaluated.
